School Dress Code

The school dress policy has been developed through a consultative process and has been endorsed by the Parent Council – and all pupils are expected to wear it. The guidelines on dress are :-

- White polo shirt or white shirt.
- Black school jumper with purple trim and school badge.
- Black trousers or skirt (no jeans of any colour).
- Sensible black shoes or boots (no trainers).
- School ties are required for formal events (concerts, prizegivings, photographs, etc).
- The school badge should be evident on at least one item of clothing.

Please note that white polo shirts and black trousers or skirt are an expectation.

Successful pupils follow the school dress code because:

- They find it comfortable.
- They are proud of their school and are keen to be “part of the team.”
- The wearing of school uniform prepares our young people for the world of work beyond school where ‘workwear’ is expected; uniform at school is a pupils ‘workwear’, ensuring they are ready to work.
- It shows they are committed to the values and activities of the school.

It is important that we all work as a school community to best support our young people. To do this it is important that young people experience a sense of belonging and this is enhanced by the school uniform at Speyside High School.
